Women Artists of the West (WAOW) is pleased to offer a generously donated scholarship by a current WAOW member to a current WAOW member in good standing. Said member must be highly motivated to focus her studies at any accredited art workshop, class, webinar or seminar (hereafter, “workshop”) that represents any art form that would be juried into the Women Artists of the West organization. The successful applicant will be seeking to improve or enhance her art abilities and/or art career.

Workshops donated may be online or in-person, and the award may be for either partial or full-value of the class offered.

Applicants must:

- Be a current active member of WAOW at time of application and workshop;
- List her website where the scholarship committee can view her body of work;
- Demonstrate an active art career - please list specifics
- Convey her reasons for applying for this scholarship; and
- Submit the Application before the deadline date.

Terms

The scholarship committee will select one WAOW member to receive a scholarship based on the quality and strength of the artwork submitted and the potential for further development. Recipients of a donated scholarship are eligible to apply for other scholarship awards.

There will be no exceptions to deadlines or other application requirements.

How to apply

To apply for an offered class, email our Scholarship Chair, Cheryl Harley-Volz with a resume/letter meeting the above requirements. Be sure to state which class you are applying for and be within the deadline specified on our WAOW website education page for said class.
